# **Plasterboard Finishing**

Jointing and finishing of Gyprock plasterboard interior installations is to be carried out in accordance with **FIGURE 1** and **TABLE 1** in this document, and the following details, so as to provide a smooth surface for decorating. Stopping and external corner beads are to be applied to all edges subject to damage.

The use of Gyprock Wet Area Base Coat or Ultra-Base MR 60 is recommended for all set sheet joints of walls required to be waterproof or water resistant. Joints in non-tiled areas (that are not designated wet areas) may be finished with Gyprock finishing compounds. A Level 4 Finish is generally the accepted level of finish for residential construction as detailed in AS/NZS2589.1 and is also recommended for commercial construction.

This requires a three-coat system, consisting of:

- Tape and tape coat
- · Second coat and
- Finish (or topping) coat.

For tiled areas installation should be to a Level 3 Finish.

FIGURE 1: SELECTING A LEVEL OF FINISH


